STIPULATION RE: AMENDED PROCEDURES
FOR CLASS-WIDE RELIEF

The parties previously entered into a Stipulation Regarding Procedures for Class-Wide Relief. The parties now desire to amend those procedures, and their prior Stipulation, as set forth below:

1. Class members shall have six weeks from the date the Notice of Class Action is mailed to either (1) “opt-out” of this lawsuit, or (2) submit a claim for overtime compensation, in the manner specified in the Notice. This deadline may be extended for good cause shown. The Oregon Survey Research Laboratory (OSRL) may, at its option, mail the Notice to class members over the course of not more than five weeks, at the rate of approximately 3,000 per week, in lieu of a single mailing.

2. The parties shall have 45 days (not 30 days, as stated in the original Stipulation) from the date of OSRL’s “recommended determination” to serve any objections. The State shall

1 not object to OSRL’s “recommended determination” on any claim unless it has a good faith legal
2 or factual basis for objecting to OSRL’s determination of that claim.
